

Examination Results and Awards/Medals

The Examination department of the University is one of the most important organ of the university as the main function of the university is to award degrees/diplomas (on the basis of examinations conducted).

During the year 2010-11 the department conducted examinations in each semester both for freshers as well as repeaters. There were 130 examinations in winter (Oct-Nov 2009) and 138 during summer (April-May 2010). 56 % examination results were declared in 30 days where as 26% results were declared within 45 days.

During the 60th convocation held in January 2011, the degrees and diplomas were awarded to 23295 students which include 29 PhD, 39 M.Phil, 3229 Masters, 268 PG Diplomas, 19141 Bachelors and 582 undergraduate diplomas as well as 7 certificates.

The awards and Medals received by the meritorious students during the convocation in January 2011 is presented in Appendix B.
