Two Developmental Workshops for the F.Y.J.C. students of S.V.T Jr. College were conducted by the students specializing in Developmental Counseling on the topics of 'Emotional Maturity' and 'Peer Relations' on 8th Jan. 2012.</p> <p>31. Sensitization workshops and projects in school: The final year students of E.C.C.E. specialization conducted three sensitization workshops for the Std. V students (approximately 120 students) of Jasudben M. L. School, Gujarat Research Society, Khar on 12th, 14th and 16th Mar. 2012, an hour daily, The theme for these workshops were Child Labour, Street Children and Children who are different</p> <p>32. The second year students also conducted a sensitization project titled 'Accepting Children with Differences' for the Std.VI students of Jasudben M.L. School on 16th Mar. 2012.</p> <p>33. T.Y B.Sc students worked at CSSC (Centre for Social Science Change) from the 17th Aug. to 28th Sept. 2011.</p> <p>34. SARAS is a research project in WIN areas up to Andheri. Through SARAS, CSSC is trying to find out correlation between the nutrition of the mother during her pregnancy and the weight of the child. This project registers women who want to go for child bearing. The women who are registered get nutrition supplement. And if a woman gets pregnant, her antenatal checkup, sonography, etc. is done and the records of every woman are maintained.</p> <p>35. Non-formal Education: The extension education activities were conducted at two centres with street children, The WMCA at Juhu Beach, Mumbai and Muncipal School at Sanyas Ashram, Ville Parle (West), Mumbai</p> <p>36. Centre for the Study of Social Change, (CSSC), Bandra (E) an NGO working in the area of the health and nutrition awareness for women and children at various community centers in Mumbai. At CSSC, the students conducted interactive sessions and awareness programs with the health workers in training on typhoid, vitamin deficiencies, cancer in children, breast cancer, etc. with the help of audio visual aids such posters, plays, and puppet shows.</p> <p>37. The intervention programs by the T.Y.B.Sc. D II students began at Mangelawadi Slum after a complete survey on the needs of the adolescent girls of the community. The results of the survey guided the students in organizing extension programs. The girls wished to have skill training in the areas of Mehendi, embroidery, fabric painting, Rangoli and the like. The students invited experts and taught the community girls six skills. The program was held from the 24th Jan. to 6th Mar. 2012.</p> <p>38. The rural program was carried out in the S.N.D.T. centers of Udwada. A day's program was conducted on the 27th of Mar. 2012. The students were introduced to various activities run by the S.N.D.T. center like Tailoring, Papad making, Family Counseling and micro finance.</p> <p>39. A Visit was organized to a Warli village on Thursday, 15th Mar. 2012 to conduct a workshop on 'Stitching a Bag as a Method of Income Generation'.</p> <p>40. A fashion show of special children from Hitech Enrichment Foundation was organized by the Department with help of S.Y B. Sc students and was coordinated by Ms. Vidya Thakur and Ms. Armaiti Shukla.
