



Examination Results and Awards / Medals

Examination Reforms 2013-14

Department of Examinations works from Examination Bhavan on Juhu campus. Major responsibility is of smooth conduct of examinations at the end of each semester. The examination department of the university conducts examination of undergraduate students from 2nd and 3rd year of three year programme. 3rd and 4th year examination of 3 year degree programme (such as B. Tech.) and 3rd, 4th and 5th year examination of 5 year degree programme (such as BBA, LLB.).

During the year 2013-14 the examination department took several progressive steps.

1. Enhancing Quality of Assessment

- a. Prepared Guidelines for appointment of Examiners, Moderators and Paper setters for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Program.
- b. Rules for revaluation were prepared to maintain the uniform quality of Assessment and reduce malpractices.

2. Examination Calendar and Result Announcement

- a. Examination Calendar, Dates of Examinations and time table were declared in the Month of July, 2013.
- b. Results of more than 90% programmes were declared within 30/45 days.

3. Internship and Research (8 credits each) 16 credits

Introduction of Internship and Research were introduced for all P.G. Programmes. The procedure for approval of the title of thesis, appointment of Internal Guide, External Referees and proforma for evaluation were carried out according to provisions of Maharashtra Universities Act 1994.

4. Convocation 2013

- a. Live webcast of convocation events was organized at selected nodal centres at Juhu, Pune, Nashik, Dhule, Satara and Amalner Colleges. The Programme was viewed by most of the students.
- b. The communication regarding the Convocation event was sent through SMS which reduced paper work, manpower and was economical.

5. "e-Suvidha" Admission, Enrollment

- a. Admission, Enrolment, Pre-Examination work, (Admit card and Supervisor Report) was implemented.
- b. Online Entry of internal marks and incentive marks at E-Suvidha Portal was carried out to minimize paperwork and easy result processing.

6. Facility to retrieve old documents

Scanning of all documents of Examinations Section was completed for easy retrieval of data.

7. Increase in number of Gold medals/Prizes

Increase in number of Gold medals/Prizes from 7 to 36 (almost 5 times increase) by constant follow up and communication with donors.

8. Full Proof and secure delivery of E-mode transfer of Question papers

Question papers (approximately 256x6) for all UG/PG Examination Centres (about 450+) Centres in the State of Maharashtra, Gujarat, U.P., Bihar and Goa were sent by E-mode transfer (saving at least Rs. 30 lacs.), which reduces time, paper work (stationery), anxiety and economy.

9. Online Evaluation of Answer books

Pilot project was conducted for B.Tech. Semester VII examination for online evaluation of answer books (May 2014.)



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During the 63rd convocation held on December 23, 2013, the degrees and diplomas were awarded to 17077 students which include 57 Ph.D., 12 M.Phil., 2616 Masters, 228 P.G. Diplomas, 13712 Bachelor and 436 undergraduate diplomas as well as 16 certificates.
