Rules for Dr. Vijaya Mulay Scholarship instituted at SNDT Women's University, Mumbai 2017-18

From the annual interest amount of the corpus grant of Rs. 10 lakhs towards Dr. Vijaya Mulay Scholarship from her 3 daughters Smt. Shree Mulay, Smt. Suhasini Mulay and Smt. Bharati Sharma, this scheme is instituted in SNDT Women's University, Mumbai. From the Academic Year 2016-17, Dr. Vijaya Mulay Scholarship will be given to one regular student of Third Year of Under Graduate Programme and one regular student from First year of post graduate Programme. Amount of the scholarship may vary every year depending on the ratio of interest Academic Section of the SNDT Women's University will have responsibility to process Dr. Vijaya Mulay Scholarship as per the following guidelines:

- Announcement of "Dr. Vijaya Mulay Scholarship" will be made on SNDT Women's University website and student applicants will be required to submit their forms to the Academic Section of SNDT Women's University, Mumbai before 20/02/18.
- **2.** All regular students of Third Year of under Graduate Programme of constituent colleges and all the regular post graduate students of first year of Post Graduate Programme of the University Departments are eligible for the scholarship.
- 3. The scholarship amount for Undergraduate student will be Rs. 30000/- per year and will be divided in two instalments, Rs. 15000/- in Semester -I and Rs. 15000/- in semester II only if the 6 monthly progress report of the student who has been awarded the scholarship, duly signed by the principal of the constituent college of SNDT Women's University is found satisfactory.
- 4. The scholarship amount for post-graduate student will be Rs. 60000/- per year and will be divided in two instalments, Rs. 30000/- in Semester -I and Rs. 30000/- in semester -II only if the 6 monthly progress report of the student who has been awarded the scholarship, duly signed by the Head of the University Department of SNDT Women's University is found satisfactory.
- **5.** With permission of Madam Vice chancellor, the Committee Members to scrutinise the applications and conduct interviews will be chosen from the disciplines from which the applications are received.
- **6.** The balance amount after disbursement of scholarship will be added to the corpus fund.
- **Eligibility**:- 1. Family income should not be more than **Rs. 20,000/-** per month.
 - 2. U. G. Scholar should be among first ten in second year.
 - 3. P. G. Scholar should be among first ten in last exam passed.
 - 4. The applicant should not be availing any other scholarship.
