Details of the Contest:-

Each college is expected to select **two best students** to participate and send their entries to the Department of Students' Welfare. The proforma is enclosed herewith. The participants should enclose the photo copies of the certificates and other documents along with the proforma for authenticity. The Proforma should have the signature & seal of the Principal.

The criteria for selection of Tejaswini will be done on the following basis:-

- Academic background as provided by the college authorities
- General knowledge

- Ability to think critically with organizing abilities
- Physical Fitness test
- Ability to express views on current topics
- Psychological testing and Logical reasoning will also be included in the test
- On the spot performance either(Dramatics, Music, Debate etc.)
- Participation in literary competitions
- General appearance, confidence and poise, sense of grooming, modulation of speech/vocabulary, smartness, etiquette system of overall personality will be considered for marking.
- Simple grooming, sarees and kurtasalwar are preferable.

Participants are expected to participate in all the events specified in the programme list.

The Open Interview will consist of the following Rounds.

**Ist Round
Introduction**

- All the contestants are introduced by the Lady of the Ceremony.

**IIInd Round
Situational Question**

- Selected contestants are given situational questions to test their thinking ability and are eliminated accordingly.

**IIIrd Round
Talent**

- Talent round to test their talents based on performances.

IVth Round**Questions by Judges**

- The Judges ask the question to eliminated five contestants and have to write and read the answers one by one.

Vth Round**Common Question**

- A Common question is given and the contestants have to write and read the answers one by one.

Kindly Note:-

All the events are compulsory for all the participants: - Each event carries certain marks. In case a student does not participate in a particular event, that many marks will be deducted.

The contestants excelling in the above mentioned series of tests will be titled '**Tejaswini**' and the **1st Runner-Up and 2nd Runner-Up and will be getting trophies and cash awards.** Beside this seven best students' will be selected in each category and will be awarded trophies.

Kindly make sure that the entry forms are duly filled in legibly and with complete details. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. The participants should carry their identify cards and they should report 30 minutes prior to the programme each day. Late comers will not be allowed to participate.
