Notification about extension of dates up to 30th November 2023 for Submission for Internal Assessment of B.A. I and B.Com I Students.

Dear B.A. I and B.Com I students,

For B.A. I and B.Com I, each paper is of total 100 marks. Out of 100 Marks, internal assessment is of 25 Marks and external assessment is of 75 marks. External assessment is to be conducted at your respective examination centres. However for internal assessment you will have to write assignments for 25 marks and submit it to the office of Centre for Distance Education (CDE). The questions for assignment are given at the end of each lessons/Course material provided by CDE.

**Internal assignments of all the subject have to be submitted
on or before November 30, 2023.**

Assessment Weightage:

- a) Internal (25 marks) and external assessment (75 Marks) are compulsory for all the students.
- b) Students have to secure the minimum passing marks in Internal and External Examination Separately. Minimum Passing marks required for internal assessment are 10 out of 25 and for External Examination 30 out of 75 marks.
- c) If any student could not submit the assignment on time or failed in internal assessment she will not be allowed to appear for External Examination and will be declared failed in the respective subject, as per the university rules.

Instructions for writing Assignments:

- a) Assignment can be submitted in typed or in handwritten form.
- b) One assignment for each subject has to be submitted separately.
