


Meanwhile, please make sure that the camera, location and system access have been enabled. Click on **enable** in the alert that shows in your browser before you proceed to begin.

ID Card Upload:


- Now you will be asked to upload image of your ID card


Confirmation for Photo and ID Card Upload :

- Otherwise click on Previous button and click and upload your Photo and ID Card again.




Exam Instructions :


- You will be taken to the exam instructions screen
