Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET) - 2024

Online Applications are invited by the Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey Women's University, Mumbai from eligible candidates for admission to Ph.D. programme in the University Departments & Recognized Research Centres / Institutes.

Candidate shall be admitted to Ph.D. programme through two stage process:-

- i. Ph.D. Entrance Test (PET), which shall be a qualifying test. The Entrance Examination will be of 100 marks with multiple choice type questions.
- ii. Personal Interview of candidates qualifying in Entrance Test/Candidates exempted from Entrance Test, to be conducted as per procedure prescribed in due course.

A. Ph.D. Online Entrance Test will be conducted in 2 parts (MCQ pattern)

- All questions shall be with multiple choices, each correct answer carries 1 Mark. No negative marking system.
- The merit list of the selected candidates will be made available on the website of the University. Weightage of 70% to the written test and 30% to the performance in the Interview shall be given while preparing the merit list.

- No separate certificate of result will be issued by the University.

- The Entrance Test for Ph.D. programme will be conducted online proctored mode.

B. Eligibility for admission to Ph.D. programme:

- Eligibility Criteria for General Category : 55 %
Reserved Category : 50 %
- i. Candidates with M.D./M.S. qualification will be considered eligible to Ph.D. Program in the Subject equivalent to medical science under the faculty of Science and Technology.
- ii. Qualification of CA/CS/ICWA shall be treated as Post-Graduate qualifications in the Faculty of Commerce & Management.

C. Exemption from appearing in Ph.D. Entrance Test:

The Candidates fulfilling at least one of the following conditions will be exempted from Entrance Test:

- i. Candidates qualified in UGC-NET/**NET-LS**/SET(Maharashtra)/GATE – (**valid Score**) /JRF/GPAT examination of apex bodies such as CSIR/ ICAR/ ICMR/UGC/**DET/CEE**, AICTE and **similar National Level Tests** will be exempted from the Entrance Test but will be required to appear for personal interview at the respective departments.
- ii. Candidates who have completed M.Phil Programme in a relevant/allied discipline(s) from a UGC recognized University/ Institute will be exempted from the Entrance Test but will be required to appear for personal interview at the respective departments.

- i. For Appearing in PET Entrance Test:
For General Category- Rs. 500/-
For Reservation Category – Rs. 350/-
- ii. Exempted from appearing Entrance Test:
For General Category – Rs. 500/-

E. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING ONLINE PET APPLICATION FORM

- ❖ Before filling the online application, please check the vacant positions for admission displayed on University Website.
- ❖ **Required documents: Candidate shall upload following documents along with Online Application:**
 - ✓ Scanned copy of Marks Statement of Bachelor / Master's Degree. (If not acquired, marksheet should be submitted at the time of personal interview).
 - ✓ Scanned copy of the Caste Certificate with Caste validity in case of Reserved Category Candidates (if applicable).
 - ✓ **Scanned copy of the Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (Valid till March – 2025)** in case of Reserved Category Candidates (if applicable).
 - ✓ Scanned copy of the Medical Certificate issued by Civil Surgeon in case of persons with Disabilities (P.H.) candidates (if applicable).
 - ✓ Scanned copy of certificate issued by Divisional Deputy Commissioner, Women & Child Development Department, Government of Maharashtra for Orphan candidates (if applicable)
- ❖ **Required documents for exemption from written test: Candidate shall upload following documents along with Online Application:**
 - ✓ Scanned copy of - UGC-NET/NET - LS/SET(Maharashtra)/GATE - (valid Score) /JRF/GPAT examination of apex bodies such as CSIR/ ICAR/ ICMR/UGC/DET, AICTE and similar national level tests qualified certificate.
 - ✓ Scanned copy of M. Phil. Marksheet and Degree Certificate.
- ❖ **General Instructions:**
 - i. Candidates who are in the final year of the qualifying examination of the course are allowed to apply for the PET. However, the admission of such candidates is subject to their passing the qualifying examination.

- ii. In case of any grievance or disputes the decision of the University shall be final and binding on all.
- iii. Admission to any program does not guarantee hostel facility or any kind of financial support in any form like Scholarship, fellowship, Earn and Learn etc. The University has independent procedures for offering such benefits.
- iv. It is the responsibility of the applicant to fulfill the eligibility conditions and comply with the admission requirements. If at any stage that a false claim has been made by the candidate or the important material facts have been concealed and / or the candidate is not eligible, her candidature shall be liable for cancellation at any stage.
- v. Candidates are NOT required to submit printout of applications/documents to the University after online submission of application. However, these documents are to be submitted at the time of personal interview.
- vi. Incomplete applications/applications without uploading required documents/applications submitted after the due date will be rejected without assigning any reason and no correspondence will be entertained by the University in this regard.
- vii. No request for the change in any information submitted in the online form will be entertained by the University.
- viii. Changes in reservation due to policy decisions of the government from time to time will be applicable.
- ix. Candidates from reserved category other than Maharashtra State shall be treated as OPEN.
- x. For clarity regarding eligibility of a particular subject, students have to confirm it from the selected Research Centre.
- xi. Admission is provisional subject to conditions on fulfilling eligibility criteria and concerned committee approval.
- xii. Vacancy positions for Ph.D. are likely to be changed.
- xiii. Admissions are completely depend upon an availability of Research Centre and Research Guide.
- xiv. The online link for submitting PET application will be **closed at midnight of 23.08.2024. No request will be entertained thereafter.**

- xv. Hall Tickets OR Email will be Issued online to all candidates, who have applied for PET-2024.
- xvi. The Ph.D. Entrance Test will be conducted In English and as per the mediums available for that subject for all four faculties except for subject Marathi, Hindi, Gujarati etc.
- xvii. Fees once paid will not be refunded in any case.
- xviii. Candidates are advised to refer the University website www.sndt.ac.in for all types of information. **No personal communication will be sent to candidates.**
- xix. PET will be an eligibility condition to apply for an admission to a Ph.D. Programme. However, it shall not ensure such an admission for Ph.D. as the case may be.
- xx. Revaluation and Photocopy facility for PET is not allowed and request for the same will not be accepted.
- xxi. The documents provided by the students along with PET examination application should be submitted by the candidates at the time of Interview. If the said documents are not submitted the admission will be considered as cancelled.
- xxii. Admission will be confirmed after verification of original documents by the concerned Research Centre concerned.
- xxiii. The online exam of PET- 2024 will be in jurisdiction of SNDT Women's University only.
- xxiv. Candidates are requested to follow NET syllabus incase if PET syllabus is not updated on SNDT Women's University website.
