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Dr Madhavi Dharankar is Associate Professor at Department of Educational Technology (DET), and SWAYAM Coordinator for SNDT Women's University. She joined Department of Educational Technology in December 2015 and now heading the department since May 2018. Dr Madhavi was with Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University (YCMOU – Nasik) from 2000 – 2015, where she was Assistant Professor in School of Education. Dr Madhavi also headed Department of Students' Welfare at YCMOU during 2014 – 15. Career-wise Dr Madhavi happened to get exposure of a variety of institutions – a private school, a teacher education college, conventional university, State Open University and now one-of-its-kind department in the first Women's University of South-East Asia.

Dr Madhavi is M Sc (Biochemistry) from University of Mumbai, M Ed (University of Mumbai), M Phil (Distance Education) (YCMOU), Ph D (Educational Communication) (YCMOU), MA (Distance Education) (IGNOU).

Dr Madhavi has guided over 40 masters' level dissertations. She is Ph D guide at SNDT Women's University. She is at present guiding three PhD scholars. Dr Madhavi was a mentor for a project during 2019 and was a developer for a project in 2020 for UNESCO under their initiative "Open Education for a Better World (OE4BW)".

Dr Madhavi is has been a member of Committee constituted by NCTE (New Delhi) for examining and suggesting a comprehensive strategy for monitoring the teacher education courses offered through ODL system in the country. She has been also a member of Visiting Teams constituted by NCTE for inspecting Teacher Education Institutes. Dr Madhavi has been a member of international review board for several events and journals.

Dr Madhavi has several publications to her credit – 05 individual books, 12 Co-authored books, 07 chapters in books. She has authored 02 individual books, 04 coauthored books and 37 chapters in study material for distance learning. She has contributed 21 chapters in training material. She has 16 papers at International and 14 papers at national Conferences to her credit. Her 16 papers have been published in journals and 15 in popular magazines. Dr Madhavi has prepared 16 SRS (System Requirement Specifications) documents for B Ed and M Ed admissions. Dr Madhavi has been a content expert for 26 modules under NMEICT and e-PG Pathashala.
