Foreword

I am happy to present the Annual report of the SNDT Women's University for the year 2010-11.

The 60th Convocation address of the SNDT Women's University was delivered by Smt. Meira Kumar, Honorable Speaker, Lok Sabha in January 2011. Among the students who received degrees and diplomas, 88 students were awarded with prizes for excellence in their fields.

The University departments and conducted institutions organized various academic activities which included 1 international seminar, 12 national seminars and 7 state level seminars along with other local and departmental activities.



Several faculty members from University departments and conducted institutions were engaged in conducting UGC sponsored Major and Minor research studies and also studies sponsored by other organizations. A total of 31 research studies were conducted during the year.

Various departments, centers received funding from Trusts and organizations for conducting projects. Major funding (Rs. 1.03 Crore) came from Department of Science and Technology (DST), GoI for the Project CURIE (Consolidation of University Research for Innovation and Excellence in Women Universities). Total funding received during the year 2010-11 was Rs. 1,73,69,905. The University department and conducted institutions also received generous donations from various individuals and institutions.

The University faculty got ample opportunity to present papers in seminars and conferences – international, national and state. The faculty members in departments and conducted institutions together presented 285 papers.

Publications are an important activity engaged in by the faculty members of the University Departments and Conducted Institutions. During the year faculty members published 131 journal articles, 38 books and book Chapters, 12 papers in conference proceedings.

International exposure to staff and students is important for expanding their horizon. During the year 2010-11, 2 students went to University of Regina, Canada for internship and 2 faculty members went abroad to present papers. Ten distinguished visitors visited various departments of the University for meetings, workshops and for delivering lectures.

SNDT Women's University provides additional Student Support Services to students on all three campuses of Churchgate, Juhu and Pune. These services include upgraded library facilities, hostel facilities for students, health center with support from L.T College of Nursing, cafeteria, guidance and counseling centers for staff and students and student placement center to offer information and ensure job availability for students.

SNDT Women's University Library strives to keep pace with a global, dynamic and technology enabled information environment to meet the expectations of its users. Library collection compromises of 372405 books & journals, 6425 theses and 6362 electronic resources.

Students of the SNDT Women's University are encouraged to participate in Sports and other physical activities. A number of treks, adventure camps, and sports coaching camps were organized during 2010-11. In addition to these, students participated in international, national, state, inter-university and inter-collegiate competitions and won many prizes. Over 3780 students participated in these competitions. The students participated in all the four state level events conducted under the aegis of Hon'ble Chancellor's Office and won runner-up trophy in Indradhanushya- Inter- university cultural festival. Ms. Ulka Barve was selected Tejaswini- 2010-11. Sixty girls from various departments and colleges of the University participated in this prestigious event.
