

Student Support Services (Academic and Non-Academic)

University Library System

University provides undergraduate and post graduate programme on three campuses. All the three campuses have excellent library resources with Main Library at Churchgate and Branch Libraries at Juhu and Pune campuses.

Hostels

All the 3 campuses provide hostel facility. The hostel at Churchgate campus has a capacity of 190 seats, at Pune campus has 400 seats and Juhu campus 400 seats.

Health Centre

The health centres conduct Annual Medical Camp. The Annual Medical Check-up was organised by the L.T. College of Nursing and the Department of Students' Welfare from August 30- September 1, 2010, Churchgate Campus and from September 2-4, 2010 at the Juhu Campus of the University. A total of 1327 students availed of this facility. A Bone Density Camp for teaching and non-teaching staff of SNDTWU was conducted on July 21, 2010. About 300 staff members attended the camp.

Cafeteria

University provides food and beverages on all three campuses through cafeteria.

Educational Guidance and Counselling Centre

University established a Department of Guidance and Counselling in 1973 to provide counselling facilities to students. The department operates from Churchgate campus but facilities are offered on request to all campuses.

Student Placement Centre

While some departments have their own placement facility for students, the Department of Student Welfare also runs a placement centre through which students register and get information about job availability.
