Information about 70th Annual Convocation Ceremony to be held through online mode on February 17, 2021

Important Details of Programme are as follows:

The 70th Annual Convocation will start at 10:30 a.m. and close at 1.00 p.m.

The Live Webcast of the seventieth Annual Convocation will be available on the Link http://estv.in/sndt and also on the You Tube.

The Hon'ble Chancellor will confer Degrees/ Diplomas in absentia upon the candidates who have qualified themselves for the same and who are presented to Hon'ble Chancellor by the Deans of respective Faculties.

The Director, Board of Examinations and Evaluation will present the Prize Winners, Gold Medalists of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor for the award of respective prizes and medals.

The convocation procession will leave the Hall at 1.00 p.m.

The Degree/Diploma Certificates will be distributed to the qualified students student at the respective colleges and University Department after a period of ten days of the Convocation

1. Seating in the Convocation Hall:

The recipient of prizes and awards alone will be permitted to be present at convocation. The seating arrangement for the winners of prizes and awardees will be made as per the guidelines of the Covid-19 Pandemic.

2. Dress Code

The recipients of the prizes and awards who have been intimated to participate in the convocation will be required wear plain white or off-white sari with border and pallu of any colour. They may wear plain white or off- white salwar kameej with coloured border along with plain white or off-white dupatta with coloured border.

3. Scarves:

It is compulsory for all the awardees who will be seated in the Convocation Hall to wear the scarves of a particular colour as per the Faculties. The scarves will be available on rent at the Accounts Section of the University at a nominal charge of Rs. 50/- per scarf and a refundable deposit of Rs. 150/-. The scarves may be collected from the Accounts Section between **08:30 a.m. to 09:30 a.m.** on the day of Convocation. After collecting the scarves, the awardees will have to go to the Patkar Hall and occupy their seats as directed by the University staff.

4. Recipients of Gold Medals, Prizes and Awards:

Recipients of gold medals, prizes and awards instituted for various programmes of studies will be a part of the Convocation Procession and they will sit in the Patkar Hall. A rehearsal will take place at 08:30 a.m. sharp on 17.2.2021 in the Patkar Hall at the Churchgate Campus. On the day of Convocation, the Gold Medalists and Prize Winners

Churchgate Campus. On the day of Convocation, the Gold Medalists and Prize Winners who fail to attend the rehearsal will not be allowed to join the convocation procession or receive the awards on the stage.

It is compulsory for those Prize Winner students, who are unable to attend the Convocation in person, to collect their Merit Certificate(s)/ Prize Winner Certificate(s) within one month from the date of Convocation, from the Pariksha Bhavan, Juhu Campus, Mumbai – 400 049.

5. Ph.D. Recipients:

The Ph.D. recipients, must collect their Ph.D. Degree Certificate within one month from the date of Convocation, from the Examinations Section, Pariksha Bhavan, Juhu Campus, Mumbai – 400 049.

The following documents will be required for collecting the Degree / Diploma Certificate from the Pariksha Bhavan or respective University Department

- a. Original Fee receipt of Rs. 500/- paid as Convocation Fee,
- b. Photocopy of Notification,
- c. Photo Identity Proof (Voters ID, Pan Card, Aadhar Card etc.)

Degree / Diploma Certificate Distribution Information:

- 1. Students who have paid their Convocation Fee at the concerned College/Institution/ University Department, but are unable to attend the Convocation can collect their Degree/Diploma Certificate from their respective Colleges/Institutions/ University Departments only, without paying any extra charges.
- 2. The Degree / Diploma Certificates will be distributed to the students at the respective Colleges / University Departments after ten days of the convocation. All those students who have paid Degree /Diploma Certificate Fee as prescribed by the Management Council Resolution Agenda Item no 14 (Appendix K) dated 06.02.2019 (i.e. Rs. 500/- for First Certificate/Diploma & Bachelor's Degree, Rs. 500/- for Master's/ Post Graduates and B.Ed. and Rs. 500/- For Ph.D Degree Certificate) to the Examinations Section and have sent their application for receiving the Degree/Diploma Certificate by post will receive their Degree/Diploma Certificate as per their request.
- 3. All students (Regular and Distance Education) should produce the following documents for collecting the Degree / Diploma Certificates at the respective Colleges/University Department /Center for Distance Education.
 - a) Original Receipt of Convocation Fee or Original Receipt of Fee paid for the Degree/Diploma Certificate
 - b) Photocopy of the Final Year Marksheet
 - c) Photo Identity Proof (College ID, Voters ID, Pan Card, Aadhar Card, etc.)
- 4. Students of the Centre for Distance Education, who have paid their Convocation Fee at the Examinations Section may collect their Degree/ Diploma Certificate from the Center for Distance Education, Juhu Campus, Santacruz (W), Mumbai 400 049 within one month i.e, between 01.03.2021 to 31.03.2021.

5. In case of non-receipt of Degree/ Diploma Certificate and/or if there is an error, in the name / class or grade/ Faculty or subject etc., the students are advised to submit an application for rectification immediately but not later than six months from the date of Convocation, at the Degree Unit of Pariksha Bhavan, Juhu Campus, Santacruz (w), Mumbai 400 049, through the concerned University Department/College.
