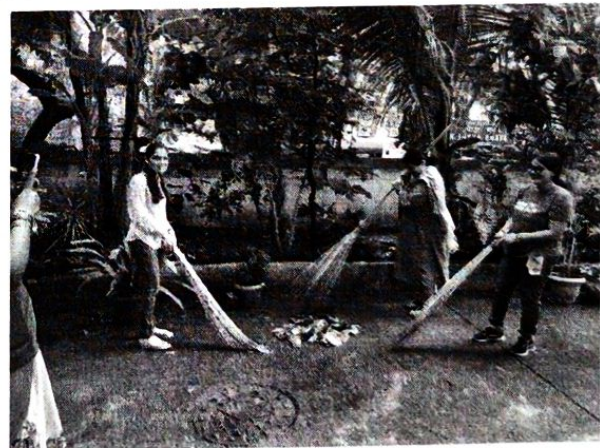
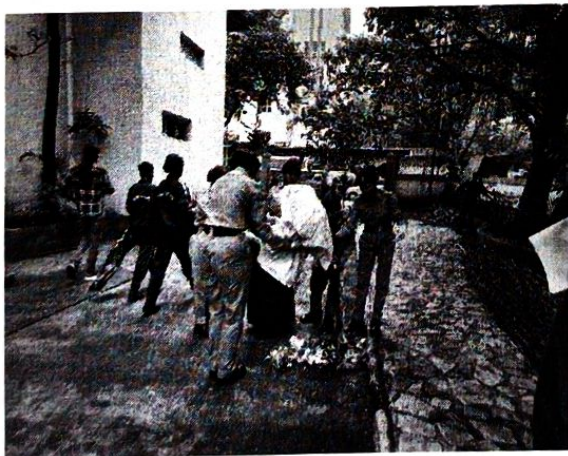
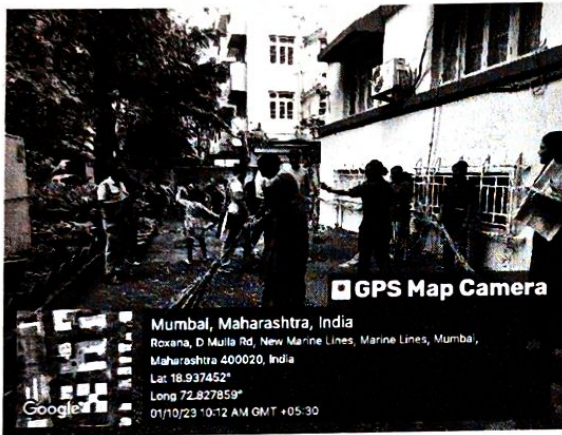


Report Extension Activity Report
