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अप्रेंटिसशिप एम्बेडेड डिग्री प्रोग्राम्स – नवे शैक्षणिक पर्वराष्ट्रीय शैक्षणिक धोरण २०२०

अप्रेंटिसशिप एम्बेडेड डिग्री प्रोग्राम्स – नवे शैक्षणिक पर्वराष्ट्रीय शैक्षणिक धोरण 2020 (National Education Policy 2020) च्या अंमलबजावणीला सध्या एक नवा वेग लाभलेला आहे. धोरण तयार करताना घेतलेली दूरदृष्टी आणि आता प्रत्यक्ष अंमलबजावणी करताना घेतले जात असलेले नवे-नवे निर्णय, यामुळे भारताचे उच्च शिक्षण क्षेत्र एका नवे वळणावर पोहोचले आहे. यामध्ये एक महत्त्वपूर्ण टप्पा म्हणजे Apprenticeship Embedded Degree Programmes (AEDP) – अप्रेंटिसशिप एम्बेडेड डिग्री प्रोग्राम्स. या संकल्पनेमागील मूळ उद्देश असा आहे की, विद्यार्थ्यांचे शिक्षण आणि इंडस्ट्रीतील गरजा यांचा समन्वय साधला जावा. याअंतर्गत, एखादा डिग्री कोर्स असा डिझाइन केला जातो की ज्यामध्ये शिक्षण घेण्यासोबतच विद्यार्थ्यांना संबंधित क्षेत्रात प्रत्यक्ष कामाचा अनुभव (on-the-job training) मिळतो. यामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांचे शिक्षण हे केवळ सैद्धांतिक न राहता, व्यवहार्य आणि रोजगारक्षम बनते.२२ एप्रिल २०२५ रोजी महाराष्ट्र शासनाने यासंदर्भातील जीआर जाहीर केला असून, राज्यातील उच्च व तंत्रशिक्षण संस्थांनी अशा अभ्यासक्रमांचे आयोजन करावे, असे स्पष्ट निर्देश दिले आहेत. या पार्श्वभूमीवर, एसएनडीटी महिला विद्यापीठ याने पूर्वीपासूनच सुरू असलेल्या इंटर्निशिप, OJT (On-the-Job Training) या संकल्पनांमध्ये आता AEDP जोडण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे.विद्यापीठाने २०१३ पासून इंटर्नशिपला महत्त्व दिले असून, आता २०२५-२६ च्या शैक्षणिक सत्रापासून विविध नव्या अभ्यासक्रमांत अप्रेंटिसशिपही अंतर्भूत केली जाणार आहे. इंडस्ट्रीला प्रत्यक्ष अभ्यासक्रम डिझाइनमध्ये सामील करून घेणे, त्यांच्या संशोधन गरजांवर आधारित विद्यार्थी प्रकल्प तयार करणे, आणि शिक्षण घेत असतानाच विद्यार्थ्यांना मानधन मिळावे – याकडे विद्यापीठाची भूमिका स्पष्ट आहे.ही शिक्षणपद्धती म्हणजे केवळ ज्ञानदान नव्हे, तर "अर्थकरी, युक्तकरी आणि मुक्तकरी" शिक्षणाचा एक सशक्त मार्ग आहे.

एसएनडीटी महिला विद्यापीठ महाराष्ट्रात या नव्या शैक्षणिक पर्वाचे एक महत्त्वाचे केंद्र बनत आहे, हे निश्चित!



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Rewriting Guardianship Laws: Time to End Gender Bias in Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956

his editorial explores the gender disparity that has been pre-existing in the society as well as the laws. Women's rights have always been curbed and the editorial has covered a small part of it. The Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 (HMGA), especially Sections 6(a) and 6(b), continues to reflect outdated gender norms by giving preferential guardianship rights to one parent over another based solely on gender and the legitimacy of the child. In the case of legitimate children, Section 6(a) favors the father, while in the case of illegitimate children, Section 6(b) favors the mother. These provisions not only perpetuate patriarchal assumptions but also violate core constitutional principles of equality, liberty, and dignity enshrined in Articles 14, 15, and 21 of the Indian Constitution.

The landmark judgment in Gita Hariharan v. RBI (1999) attempted to soften the discriminatory interpretation by reading "after" the father to mean "in the absence of." However, this judicial maneuver didn't dismantle the entrenched assumption of paternal superiority in guardianship. The presumption that a father is more suited to be a guardian unless proven otherwise continues to undermine gender parity and burdens mothers with having to demonstrate the father's inadequacy.

This legal bias is both unconstitutional and unsupported by the welfare principle—the cornerstone of guardianship jurisprudence. The child's welfare, as outlined in Section 13 of the HMGA, should override traditional assumptions. Welfare isn't confined to financial capacity; it encompasses emotional, psychological, and physical well-being—domains where either parent may be more suitable depending on the situation.

Further, the Act's terminology of "legitimate" and "illegitimate" children has become increasingly redundant and discriminatory, especially when laws like the Hindu Marriage Act and Special Marriage Act grant legitimacy even to children born from void marriages. In today's context of rising cohabitation and non-traditional families, assigning custody based on legitimacy only exacerbates injustice and fails to reflect lived realities.

Internationally, India is bound by conventions like CEDAW and the UDHR, both of which mandate gender equality in family law. The current framework in the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 (herein referred to as "HGMA") violates these norms by institutionalizing gender stereotypes. Significantly, even the British statute the HMGA draws from has been amended to ensure parental equality.

Right to guardianship, as argued, falls under the purview of personal liberty under Article 21. Parenthood is a deeply personal and identity-shaping role; denying equal opportunity based on sex is a denial of autonomy, dignity, and individuality.

What India needs is a paradigm shift—from a presumption of preference to a principle of parity. Both parents should be treated equally under the law, with guardianship decisions based solely on the best interest of the child, not gender stereotypes. Until Parliament acts, it is upon the judiciary to rise and fulfill the Constitution's promise of equality—not just on paper, but in the everyday lives of parents and children alike.



LECTURE ON HISTORY OF EUROPEAN UNION SOCIAL LAW

Students of Post-graduation degree part 1 & 2 of MA Political Science were invited for the special lecture on HISTORY OF EUROPEAN UNION SOCIAL LAW by PROF. BART ROELS (A distinguished Lecturer in Social and European Law at AP Hogeschool Antwerpen.
