B.Ed./M.Ed. Common Entrance Test (CET) - 2025

Online Applications are invited by the Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey Women's University, Mumbai from eligible candidates for admission to B.Ed. / M.Ed. programme in the affiliated colleges situated in the states other than Maharashtra.

Candidate shall be admitted to B.Ed. /M.Ed. programme by a one stage process through: -

B.Ed. / M.Ed. CET is a qualifying test. The CET will be of 100 marks with multiple choice type questions.

➤ **Schedule of B.Ed./M.Ed. CET Exam:**

1. Date of online Examination	: 05.10.2025
2. Commencement of filling online applications	: 18.09.2025
3. Last date of filling online applications	: 27.09.2025
4. Mock Test will be Conducted	: 01.10.2025
5. Result Declaration	: 09.10.2025

- No separate certificate of result will be issued by the University.
- Both B.Ed. / M.Ed. CET will be conducted by online computer-based proctored mode.
- There is no negative marking system in the exam.
- Questions will be made available in both Hindi and English languages.

A. Eligibility for admission to B.Ed./M.Ed. programme:

For B.Ed.: -

The applicants must go through the MAH B.Ed. CET-2025 eligibility criteria before considering the application for the exam. The detailed eligibility criteria for B.Ed. CET is given below:

Nationality: The applicant must be a citizen of India.

Education Qualification: The applicant must have a Bachelor's degree/master's degree in any of the course like science and mathematics / social sciences / Humanities / Commerce etc. The candidate should have minimum 50% marks if belonging to General Category and 45% marks if belonging to the reserved category.

OR

The applicant must have a Bachelor's degree/master's degree in subjects like Engineering & Technology, Computer Science/ Law/ Information technology/ Agriculture/ Banking and Insurance/ Medical Sciences/ Fine Art/ Performing Art.

They must have secured a minimum of 55% marks for the General category and 50% marks for the reserved category belonging to the state of Maharashtra.

(Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other applicable categories shall be as per the rules of the state of Maharashtra whichever is applicable).

For M.Ed.: -

Nationality: The applicant must be a citizen of India.

A. Candidates seeking admission to the M.Ed. programme should have obtained at least 50% marks of an equivalent grade in the following programmes:

- (i) B.Ed.
- (ii) B.A.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed.
- (iii) B.El.Ed.
- (iv) D.El.Ed. with an Undergraduate degree (with 50% marks in each)

B. Pass in CET of Government of Maharashtra

(Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other applicable categories shall be as per the rules of the state Govt. whichever is applicable).

- ❖ Before filling the online application, refer all the instruction.
- ❖ **Required documents: Candidate shall upload following documents along with Online Application:**
 - ✓ Scanned copy of Marks Statements of SSC, HSC, Bachelor Programme and Masters Programme.



- ✓ Scanned copy of the Caste Certificate with Caste validity in case of Reserved Category Candidates (if applicable).
- ✓ Scanned copy of the Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in case of Reserved Category Candidates (if applicable).
- ✓ Scanned copy of the Medical Certificate issued by Civil Surgeon in case of persons with Disabilities (P.H.) candidates (if applicable).

❖ **General Instructions:**

- i. In case of any grievance or disputes the decision of the University shall be final and binding on all.
- ii. Admission to any program does not guarantee hostel facility or any kind of financial support in any form like Scholarship, fellowship, Earn and Learn etc. The University has independent procedures for offering such benefits.
