It is hereby informed that, as recommended by the University Grants Commission (D.O. letter No. F.1-1/2014 (Secy) dt. 12.11.2014), the Academic Council, vide its resolution no.13 dated April 17, 2015 has decided to implement the 10 Point Grade Scale System for various grades of passing related to different Courses of Studies/Programmes, with effect from the academic year 2015 -16.

In case of the examinations of the Semester I and II or Semester I, II, III and IV which are being conducted by the concerned University Departments/Colleges, on behalf of the University, as the case may be, it shall be necessary to mention the standard of passing/grading, overleaf the marksheet to be issued to the students. Such marksheets must be prepared in the prescribed format and the same be duly signed and authenticated by the Head of the concerned University Department or the Principal of the College before sending it to the Controller of the Examinations, for endorsement.

A copy of the 10 Point Grade Scale System as approved by the Academic Council is enclosed herewith for information and necessary action.
