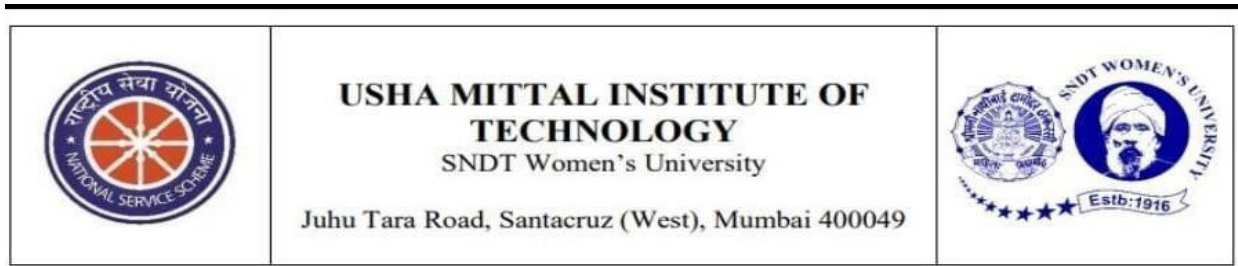

TREE PLANTATION EVENT

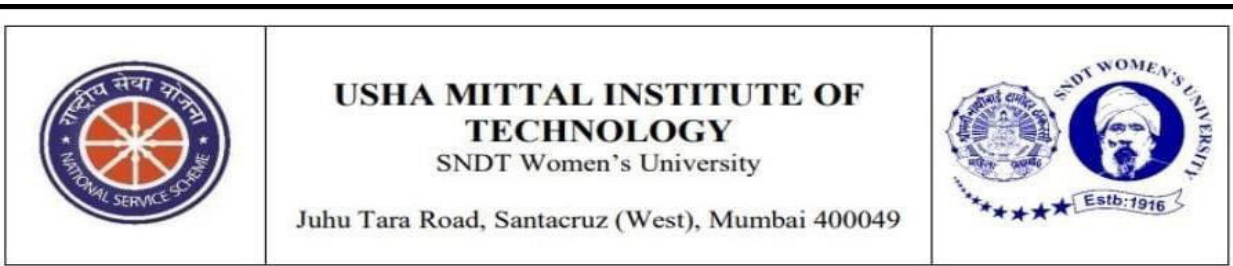

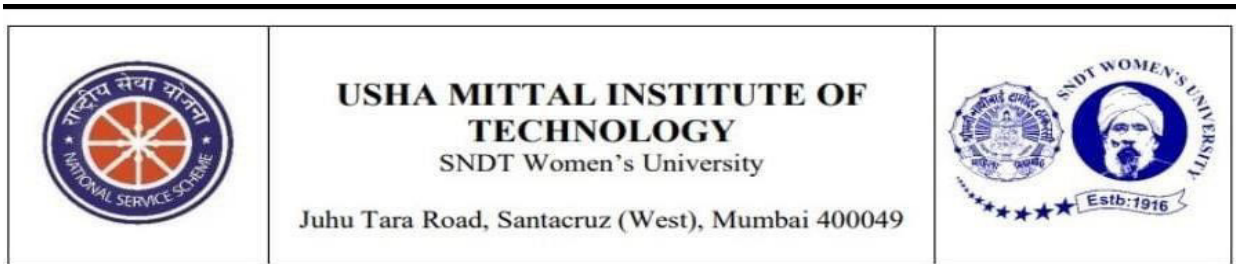

ABSTRACT:

The NSS UNIT Of Usha Mittal Institute Of Technology organized a successful Blood Donation and Thalassemia Checkup Camp on the 11th of October, 2023, With Collaboration Of Hinduridaysamrat Balasaheb Thackeray Blood Bank And Trauma Care B.M.C Hospital in the Conference Room on the first floor. The event commenced at 10:00 AM and featured blood donation as well as thalassemia checkup services. The event primarily focused on promoting awareness about the importance and benefits of blood donation.

It was a well-organized and safe initiative, with a strict criterion that allowed girls with a body weight of 45 kilograms or more to participate in blood donation. This ensured that the donors were in a suitable condition to contribute. Qualified medical representatives from the hospital were present at the event to oversee the blood donation process, ensuring the safety and well-being of the donors.

The presence of healthcare professionals added an extra layer of reassurance for the participants. After the blood donation process, donors were offered the opportunity to undergo a Thalassemia checkup. 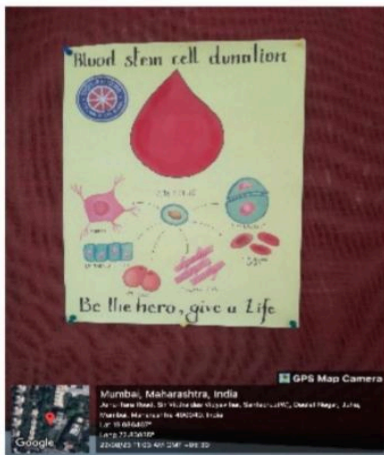
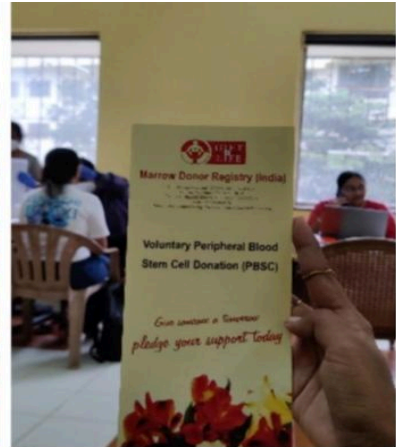
