About BMK-KRC

Bharatratna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre (BMK-KRC) is a multi-unit University Library System; located at SNDT Women's University, New Marine Lines, with branch Libraries located at the Pune and Juhu campuses. We desire to provide a culturally relevant collection of quality material in Marathi, Hindi, English, Gujarati and Sanskrit. It is our aim that our students become information literate, we also provide instruction on the access and the use of all our resources.

BMK Knowledge Resource Centre has always been striving hard to meet the expectations of its users. More than 40 qualified professionals run the library assisted by other support staff. Outside users are welcome at the BMK Knowledge Resources Center. However, we only loan materials to SNDTWU, students, faculty, staff, and to alumni within one year of graduation. Interlibrary loan service (ILL), computers, and access to databases are restricted to SNDTWU students, faculty, and staff.

Vision

The BMK-Knowledge Resource Centre seeks to facilitate seamless access to quality knowledge and information resources in all formats. To execute this vision, the BMK-KRC will create congenial atmosphere that will allow interface of library resources for integrative scholarship.

Mission

The BMK-Knowledge Resource Centre is committed to empowerment of women by providing resources & services with ICTs that are essential to teaching, learning, research and creation of knowledge systems. To realize this mission, the BMK-KRC is committed to create hospitable physical and virtual environment for study, teaching and research.

Goals/Objectives

- To reach out to all women learners with resources and services across class and caste boundaries.
- To Integrate services and technologies that are essential for learning, research and creation of Knowledge.
- To develop print, audio-visual and digital collections relevant to the users.
- To develop the BMK-KRC website to enable access to digital resources to all stake holders.

- To ensure the preservation and long-lasting availability of BMK-KRC resources, archival material and specialized collection in vernacular languages in all formats.
- To address the changing needs of the BMK-KRC teaching-learning community with 24x7 access.
- To foster and promote a co-operative culture of dynamic critical thinking to help the BMK-KRC emerge as the centre of excellence.

Highlights 2023-24

Over the past year, the BMK-Knowledge Resource Centre has remained committed to its mission of providing access to knowledge, fostering learning, and serving as a community hub for intellectual growth and enrichment. During the year there is a slight increase in the membership of students, staff, guest members and non SNDT members. This notable growth can be attributed to the diverse range of programs, resources, and services we offer, appealing to a broader demographic within our community.

This year has been a period of significant growth and innovation for the BMK-Knowledge Resource Centre. In the year 2023-24, we upgraded our online library automation system from SLIM21 to Koha, which is a user-friendly platform with advanced search capabilities. Additionally, we launched a My Loft remote access service having a feature of mobile app that allows users to access library e-resources, and locate books on the go.

In 2023, the BMK-KRC expanded its collections by 2661 books with a focus on literature, geography, psychology, social sciences, management, literature, nursing, commerce and home science, etc. The informal exchanges and donations through various sources continued to supplement the purchased books. We thankfully acknowledge individuals, institutional donors and government bodies for their valuable offerings which have enriched the library collection.

The BMK-KRC and University of Mumbai in collaboration with Indian Library Association, New Delhi have successfully conducted the 7th MUCLA National Conference on “Challenges and Opportunities in Adapting Digital Technologies in Libraries” on 6th & 7th March 2024.

BMK-KRC in collaboration with Bombay Science Librarians Association (BOSLA) conducted a seminar on “Developing Reading Habits: Competencies, Skills and Techniques for Librarians” on 19th August 2023 at Patkar Hall, SNDT Women’s University, Mumbai.

The yearly Granthotsav, a festival of books, was held in all three KRCs. At Churchgate campus, Granthotsav was celebrated during 5th to 6th January 2024. At Juhu campus from 31st October to 1 November 2023 and at Pune campus it was celebrated from 5th to 7th February 2024. Various fun filled activities were organized like open crossword, memory game, bookmark making game, fun game were held. Eminent speakers such as Dr. Nitin Rindhe, Mr. Suresh Menon, Dr. Ashwini Dhongde were invited to deliver lectures.

This year, KRC started using plagiarism software “Drillbit” received from INFLIBNET. To meet with the challenge of managing technology, training of all levels of staff has been an ongoing and continuing process.

We also digitized rare and historical documents from our Special Collections, making them accessible to a wider audience through institutional repository. To ensure the collection remains relevant, we weeded 5331 outdated items and reinvested those funds in new acquisitions.

The library mainly organized orientation programmes for undergraduate students and user education workshops for postgraduate students. The guests, non SNTD and distance education members were also individually guided to enable them to retrieve information from library resources. The objectives of the programmes were to introduce library resources and services and to develop competencies in users to retrieve needed information. The user education programmes were well appreciated by the participant students, teachers, guest members and non SNTD members.

Overall, KRC showed commitment to support students, faculty, and staff with the resources and services they need to succeed in their academic endeavours. KRC also continued to expand digital resources and explore innovative ways to provide research assistance to students.

Highlights

The year aimed to achieve more visibility and increase the use of KRC resources. The visit of NAAC at the KRC was good. NAAC visited KRC Juhu on 18.4.2023. The visit was for 3 days April 17 to 19, 2023.

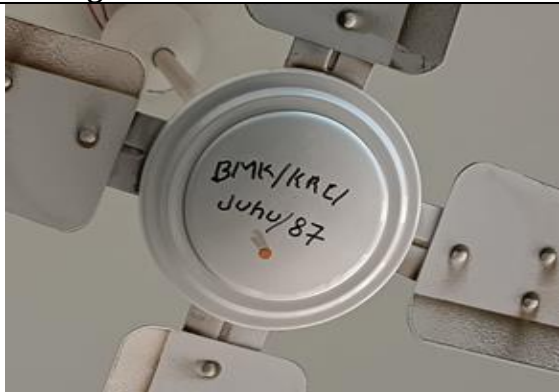

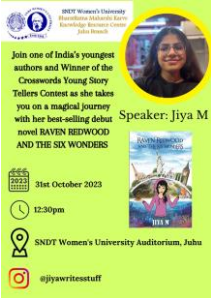
