About BMK-KRC:

Bharatratna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre (BMK-KRC) is a multi-unit University Library System located at SNDT Women's University, New Marine Lines, with branch Libraries located at the Pune and Juhu campuses. We desire to provide a culturally relevant collection of quality material in Marathi, Hindi, English, Gujarati and Sanskrit. It is our aim that our students become information literate, we also provide instruction on the access and the use of all our resources.

BMK Knowledge Resource Centre has always been striving hard to meet the expectations of its users. More than 40 qualified professionals run the library assisted by other support staff. Outside users are welcome at the BMK Knowledge Resources Center. However, we only loan materials to SNDTWU, students, faculty, staff, and to alumni within one year of graduation. Interlibrary loan service (ILL), computers, and access to databases are restricted to SNDTWU students, faculty, and staff.

Vision:

The BMK-Knowledge Resource Centre seeks to facilitate seamless access to quality knowledge and information resources in all formats. To execute this vision, the BMK-KRC will create a congenial atmosphere that will allow the interface of library resources for integrative scholarship.

Mission:

The BMK-Knowledge Resource Centre is committed to empowerment of women by providing resources & services with ICTs that are essential to teaching, learning, research and creation of knowledge systems. To realize this mission, the BMK-KRC is committed to create a hospitable physical and virtual environment for study, teaching and research.

Goals/Objectives

- To reach out to all women learners with resources and services across class and caste boundaries.
- To Integrate services and technologies that are essential for learning, research and creation of Knowledge.
- To develop print, audio-visual and digital collections relevant to the users.
- To develop the BMK-KRC website to enable access to digital resources to all stakeholders.

- To ensure the preservation and long lasting availability of BMK-KRC resources, archival material and specialized collection in vernacular languages in all formats.
- To address the changing needs of the BMK-KRC teaching-learning community with 24x7 access.
- To foster and promote a co-operative culture of dynamic critical thinking to help the BMK-KRC emerge as the centre of excellence.

Highlights 2024-25

The Bharatratna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre (BMK-KRC) of SNDT Women's University continued to play a pivotal role in supporting the academic, research, and cultural needs of students and faculty throughout the year. Significant efforts were made towards collection development, including the addition of new books, journals, and digital resources, ensuring comprehensive coverage across disciplines. Orientation sessions were conducted for all courses across departments and colleges, benefitting over 1800 students and equipping them with the necessary skills to utilize library resources effectively.

To strengthen digital access, the library expanded its e-resources and improved remote login facilities, ensuring seamless availability of e-books, e-journals, and databases for students and researchers. User engagement remained a key focus through library tours, information literacy programs, and interactive events, including author meets and book talks in collaboration with academic departments. Infrastructure and technology upgrades, such as enhancements to the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) and the introduction of user-friendly services, further enriched the overall library experience. Additionally, the library extended research support through reference services and plagiarism checks, reinforcing its role as a vital academic hub for the university community.

The SNDT Women's University, Bharatratna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre achieved a significant milestone by gaining access to the **One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) initiative (code U0326)**. This initiative provides free access to over 13,000 electronic journals from 30 publishers to more than 6,300 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) across the country. The subscription, valid from January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2027, will significantly enhance the academic resources available to the university community.

The yearly **Granthotsav, a festival of books**, was held in all three KRCs. At Churchgate campus, Granthotsav was celebrated during 10th to 11th October 2024. A program entitled "शब्दांच्या गावा जावे" by Mrs. Deepali Kelkar was conducted. At Juhu campus from 28th-30th August 2024. Dr. Shubhangini Ashok Joshi, Dr. Vinaya Nagpure (Ayurvedic Consultant) Mr. Nitin Kamble, Yoga Instructor and Dr. Deelip D. Mestri (University Librarian, Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj University) were invited to deliver lectures. At Pune campus it was celebrated from 17th -18th October 2024. Various fun filled activities were organized like open crossword, memory game, bookmark making game, fun game was held. A famous Youtuber and social influencer Konkani Ranmanus Mr. Prasad Gawade was invited to deliver lecture on eco-freindly sustainable eco-tourism

A RUSA-sponsored **two-day National Conference on “Open Access to Scholarly Information: Research & Academic Communities Role in Building a Sustainable Knowledge Society”** organized by Dr. BMN College of Home Science, in collaboration with SHPT School of Library Science and BharatRatna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre, SNDT Women’s University, Mumbai, on September 20–21, 2024 at Smt. MMP Shah College of Arts and Commerce for Women, Mumbai. The event featured distinguished speakers including Dr. Sridhar Gutam, Dr. Susmita Das, Dr. Deepali Kuberkar, and Dr. Mohit Garg, who addressed topics such as open access as a catalyst for sustainable knowledge, responsible publishing, predatory journals, and the current landscape of open access. The conference also hosted a panel discussion with experts like Dr. Meghana Sanjeeva, Dr. Kaushal Giri, Dr. Sunita Pujar, Dr. Vrushali Dandavate, and Dr. Shantashree Sengupta, who shared insights on advocacy, infrastructure, transformative agreements, OA policies, and repository management, making it a significant step towards fostering awareness and collaboration for open access in academic and research communities.

Under the '**Vachan Sankalp Maharashtra**' initiative, the BMK-KRC actively promoted a culture of reading among students and faculty. Various activities such as book exhibitions, thematic displays, and interactive reading sessions were organized to encourage the habit of regular reading. Special efforts were made to highlight Marathi literature and notable works by renowned authors of Maharashtra. Through these initiatives, the library aimed to inspire readers to take a pledge towards lifelong learning and foster a vibrant reading environment on three campuses. Under this program, BMK-KRC organised book exhibitions, thematic displays, and reading sessions to promote Marathi literature and encourage a culture of reading among students and faculty."

SNDT Women’s University, BharatRatna Maharshi Karve Knowledge Resource Centre organized a **7-day Online Orientation Program for Faculty Members from 3rd to 10th January 2025**. The sessions introduced participants to a wide range of academic databases and resources. The program began with an introduction by Dr. Subhash Chavan, Director KRC, followed by demonstrations of databases such as ProQuest Central, ProQuest Psychology One, World Ebook Library, Perlego, Brill HSS Journals, EPWRF, Indiastats, Emerald, Sage Journals, Project Muse, Women’s Studies Archives, IEEE, Packt E-Books, Bentham Science, CINAHL, DELNET, and MyLoft Remote Access Platform. The sessions were coordinated by experts including Dr. Vrushali Rane, Dr. Vilas Jadhav, Dr. Manisha Jadhav, Dr. M. Bangar, and Ms. Jayashree Kamble, making the program highly informative and beneficial for faculty members in enhancing their research and teaching resources.

BMK-KRC, Pune branch with the Departments of Commerce, Economics and JDBIMSR, of SNDT Women's University, Pune Campus, in collaboration with Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's Hazarimal Somani College of Arts and Science, Shri Manubhai Maneklal Sheth Jr. College, and Jayaramdas Patel College of Commerce and Management Studies, were jointly organized the **National Conference on "The AI Revolution – Opportunities and Challenges in Various Sectors (NCAI 2025)" on 14th February 2025** at JDBIMSR Auditorium, Pune. The conference aims to explore the transformative role of Artificial Intelligence in commerce, economics, finance, education, healthcare, agriculture, transport, governance, and other fields, highlighting both opportunities and challenges in implementation. With the theme "Harnessing AI to Improve Sectoral Performances," the event will provide a platform for academicians, researchers, industry experts, and students to share insights, case studies, and research through paper presentations, discussions, and collaborations. Sub-themes include AI in e-commerce, finance, healthcare, education, agriculture, public sector, and ethical AI, among others. Selected papers will be published in peer-reviewed journals, making this conference a significant step toward understanding AI's impact on sustainable development and innovation across multiple sectors.

Overall, KRC showed its strong commitment to supporting students, faculty, and staff by providing essential resources and services to enhance their academic endeavors. Along with continuously expanding digital resources and exploring innovative ways of offering research assistance, KRC also organized impactful programs such as the "वाचन संकल्प महाराष्ट्राचा उपक्रम" (1st–15th January 2025), the Constitution Day Celebration (26th November 2024), the 7-Day Online Database Orientation Program (3rd–10th January 2025), the RUSA-Sponsored National Conference on Open Access to Scholarly Information (20th–21st September 2024), and the upcoming National Conference on The AI Revolution – Opportunities and Challenges in Various Sectors (NCAI 2025) (14th February 2025). These initiatives not only enriched the academic environment but also reflected KRC's dedication to fostering a culture of learning, research, and innovation across the University community.

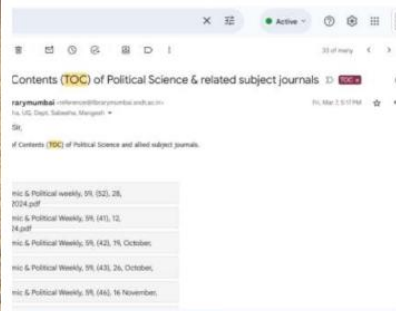

Highlights

The SNDT Women's University Juhu Knowledge Resource Centre (KRC) achieved a significant milestone by gaining **access to the One Nation One Subscription (ONOS)** initiative (code U0326). This initiative provides free access to over 13,000 electronic journals from 30 publishers to more than 6,300 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) across the country. The subscription, valid from January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2027, will significantly enhance the academic resources available to the university community.

In a move towards modernization, the library successfully implemented the **Koha** Integrated Library System. Additionally, rare books were digitized to preserve the institution's rich heritage while making them accessible to a wider audience. These initiatives demonstrate the KRC's commitment to leveraging technology to enhance resource availability.

Student-centric developments were a key focus this year. The **Competitive Exam Corner** was further developed with the addition of new books and journals, catering to students preparing for various competitive exams. **Women's studies corner** was also established with the books, bound volumes, journal issues from the existing collection. Another innovative addition was the **Makerspace**, equipped with interactive games that have proven to be a popular stress buster for students. To enhance engagement, the KRC relaunched its **Facebook** page and launched a new **Instagram** page, expanding its digital outreach to connect better with students and faculty.

The library also organized **online database orientation** programs to familiarize users with the vast array of resources available. It was organised for the SNDT WU CPJ campus and affiliated colleges which included all the faculty members, students, researchers and librarians. The sessions were organised online for 14 days from 3rd February to 21st February 2025 from 2pm to 4pm. In all 16 databases were covered. Online Feedback was taken and the analysis report was prepared. 532 participants were given certificates.

As part of its commitment to student development, newspaper clippings were systematically displayed to encourage reading and were utilized to conduct various activities. Additionally, plagiarism checks using **Drillbit** were streamlined to focus solely on PhD theses and PhD-related articles, ensuring academic integrity within research activities.

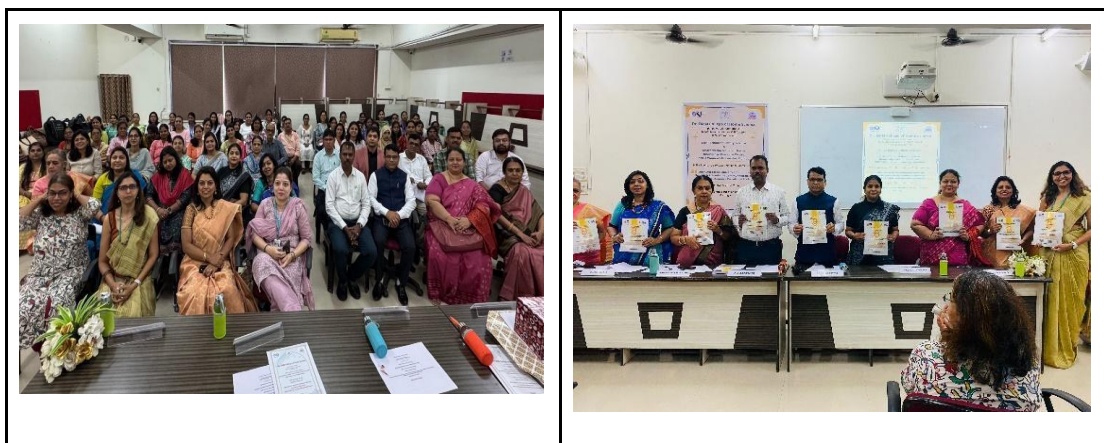
Infrastructure upgrades played a crucial role in enhancing the library's physical space. This included extending bookshelves in the Competitive Exam Corner, installing a fence partition, repairing the first-floor terrace door, and adding a single-sided book rack. These improvements have created a more organized and accessible environment for users.

To ensure the smooth functioning and continuous improvement of digital resources, an AMC for DSpace maintenance and updates was awarded to SoftTech Solutions Pune (Chetan Taksale) for five years (2024–2029). The KRC also benefited from collaborations, such as hosting interns from Mumbai University in May 2024, providing practical exposure to library operations.

Regular KRC Committee meetings & Director DL meetings were held throughout the year, facilitating effective decision-making and contributing to the overall growth and efficient management of the KRC.

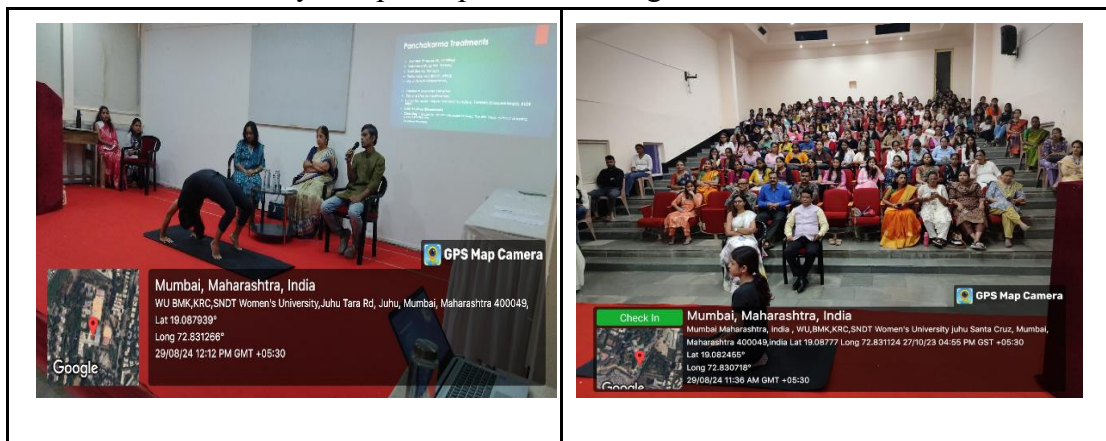
Programmes Organized

1. The National Conference on Open Access to Scholarly Information (OASI) was successfully held on September 20 and 21, 2024. The conference provided an important platform for discussions on open access and its role in enhancing scholarly communication.



2. From August 28 to 30, 2024, Granthotsav was celebrated with a vibrant three-day Book Exhibition, which attracted students and staff alike. During this event, the Maker Space, Competitive Exam Book Corner (featuring 31 new books), and the Instagram page of the Juhu Knowledge Resource Centre were inaugurated. A highlight of Granthotsav

was the Trio Talk on "Balanced Living: Ayurvedic and Yogic Path to Complete Wellness", held at 11 a.m. in the mini auditorium. Moderated by Dr. Shubhangini Ashok Joshi, Retired In-Charge Principal of P.V. Polytechnic, SNDT Women's University, the session featured insights from Dr. Vinaya Nagpure, an Ayurvedic Consultant, and Mr. Nitin Kamble, a Yoga Instructor. The talk also included a live demonstration of Yoga Asanas by Ms. Shivali Develkar, a freelance illustrator. This session was attended by 170 participants, including students, teachers, and staff.



- To foster engagement and creativity, games and competitions such as Treasure Hunt, bookmark making, and Library Lingo were organized for staff and students. Winners of these events were awarded cash prizes. The event also recognized outstanding library users, with Dr. Rohini Waghmare (Pharmacy College) receiving the Best Faculty User Award and Ms. Shital Gund (Pharmacy College) receiving the Best Student User Award.

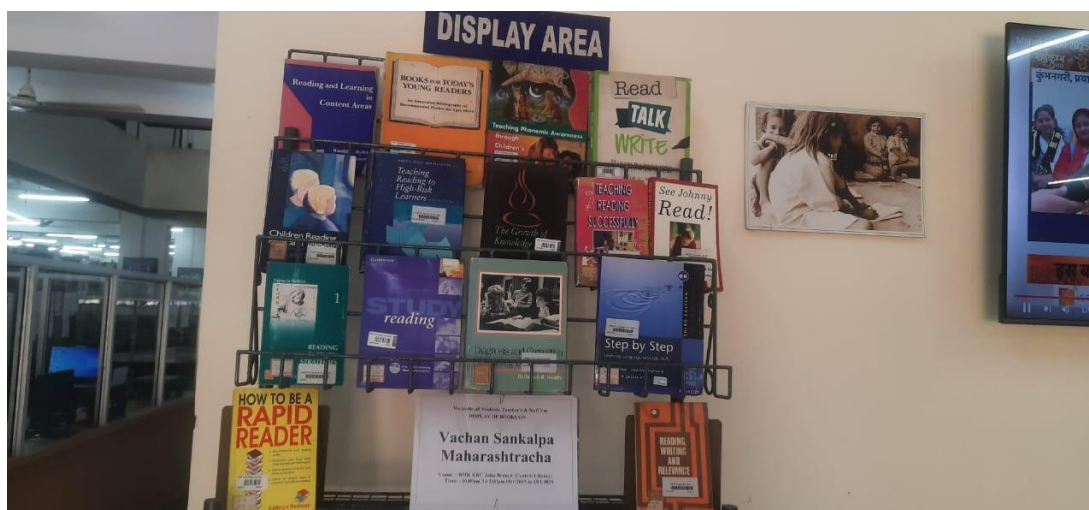

5. As part of Vachan Sankalp Maharashtra conducted 5 activities as follows –

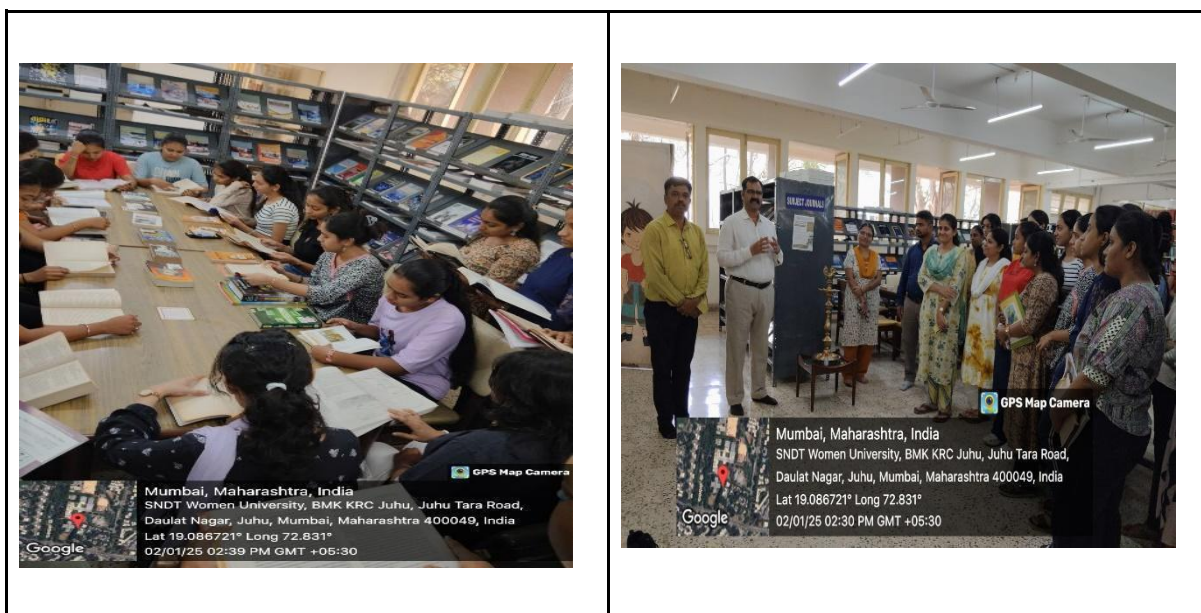
Display of books on Reading (1st January, 2025)

A session on book analysis and narration was held, wherein students reviewed and analyzed books displayed in the library. The students provided narrations of the books, sharing insights and interpretations.



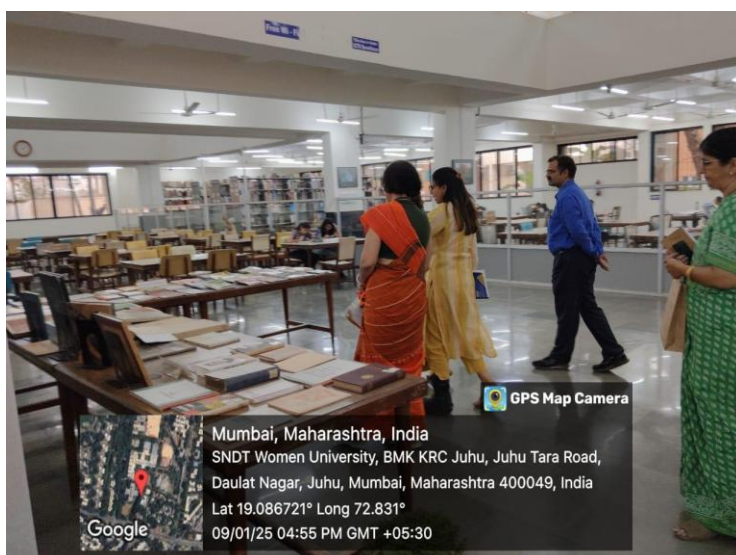
Rapid Reading (4th January, 2025)

A rapid reading session was held, where participants read quickly without losing meaning. It helped them get through more material in less time while still understanding it, making it helpful for any type of reading.



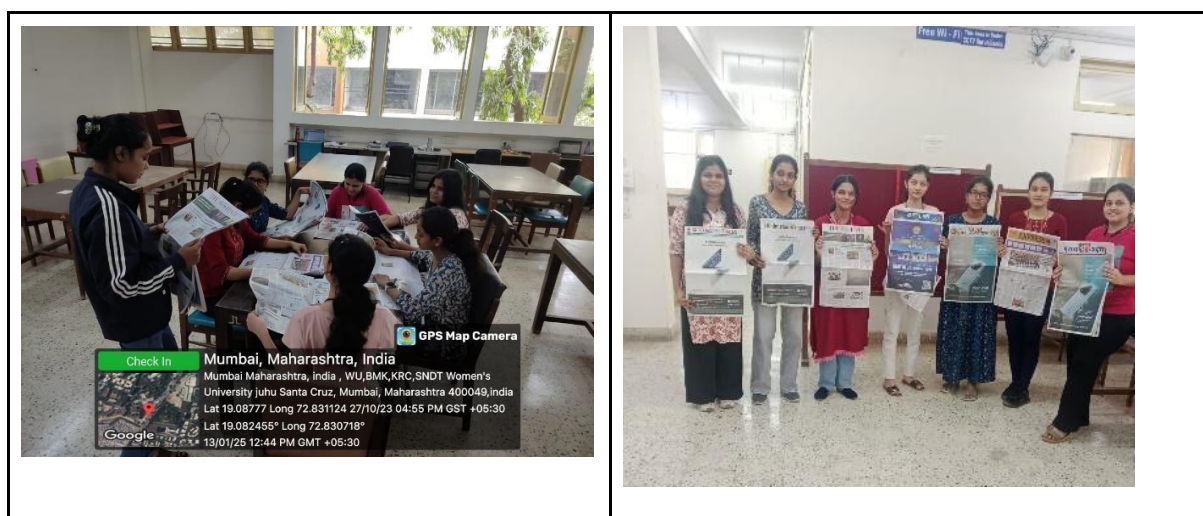
Book Exhibition (9th January, 2025)

Annual Survey Report

Use of E-Resources by Faculty at SNDT Women's University, Juhu Campus

As part of our ongoing efforts to enhance academic resource usage and support digital learning, an annual survey titled “Use of E-Resources by Faculty at SNDT Women's University, Juhu Campus” was conducted. The survey aimed to evaluate awareness, usage patterns, preferences, and challenges related to electronic resources among faculty members.

The survey adopted a descriptive methodology and data was gathered through a structured questionnaire. Analysis of the responses provided valuable insights, from which key findings, conclusions, and actionable recommendations were drawn.

Key Findings:

- Response Rate: Out of 118 questionnaires distributed, 78 were returned, reflecting a 66% response rate.
- Gender Representation: 76% of respondents were female faculty members, showcasing strong female engagement.
- Awareness of Library Collections: 82% of faculty members reported awareness of the library's collections.
- Use of Other Libraries: 58% reported accessing other libraries when required.
- Duration of Library Visits: 67% spend less than 30 minutes ; 30% spend 1–2 hours ; Remaining 3% spend more than 2 hours per visit
- Frequency of Library Visits: 4% visit daily ; 22% visit 2–3 times a week ; 24% visit weekly ; 44% visit bi-weekly ; 6% visit monthly
- Awareness of Publishing Sources: 79% were aware of subject-specific publishing sources.
- Use of Abstracting and Indexing Services: 68% reported using these resources.
- Consultation with Library Staff: A significant 92% seek assistance from library staff as needed.
- Type of Resources Used: 27% use only online resources ; 2% rely solely on offline resources ; 71% use both
- Comfort with E-Resources: 99% expressed comfort in using e-resources.
- Access to E-Resources: 94% have access; 6% did not respond.
- E-Resources vs. Print: 35% believe e-resources can replace print ; 65% prefer to retain print materials
- Self-Evaluation of E-Resource Knowledge: 62% rate their knowledge as good ; 37% average ; 1% poor
- Perceived Effectiveness of E-Enriched Libraries: 94% believe such libraries enhance effectiveness.
- Impact of E-Resources on Library Visits: 69% noted an impact on visit frequency.

- Sources of Information About E-Resources: Library staff (42); Orientation programs (36) ; Library notifications (36) ; Colleagues (22) ; HoD meetings (10) ; Other sources (6)
- Challenges Faced Using E-Resources: Lack of full-text access (42) ; Slow access/download speeds (27) ; Irrelevant content (17) ; Lack of training (17) ; Time-consuming usage (16) ; Limited library support (1) ; Other issues (8)
- Preferred Training Methods: Onsite training at the library (35) ; Online/video modules (35) ; Department-level sessions (22) ; Customized programs (20) ; Other (1)
- Awareness and Usage of Available E-Resources: While most faculty are aware of available resources, their actual usage is limited. Frequently used platforms include Shodhganga, IEEE, Elsevier Pharmacy, JSTOR, J-Gate, and Pearson. This highlights the need for targeted training and improved support mechanisms to increase engagement.

Conclusions: In today's digital era, access to reliable electronic information is pivotal for academic and professional advancement. The survey indicates that while awareness of e-resources is fairly high, actual utilization remains modest. Despite time constraints due to teaching duties and institutional responsibilities, it is imperative for faculty to actively engage with e-resources.

The SNDT Women's University, Juhu Campus, is well-equipped with digital resources, yet their potential remains underutilized. Promoting digital literacy and integrating e-resources into daily academic practice is essential for keeping pace with evolving educational standards.

Recommendations:

- Conduct regular training programs to enhance faculty familiarity and proficiency with e-resources.
- Launch awareness campaigns to inform faculty about newly added resources.
- Promote blended usage of both print and digital materials.
- Augment library staffing to meet increasing information service demands.
- Encourage inter-departmental collaboration for sharing best practices and resource knowledge.
