

### Minutes of Meeting


A meeting of Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Pharmacy was held on 12<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at 2.30 pm in committee room, S.N.D.T. Women's University, Juhu Campus. Following members were present for the meeting:




The agenda of the meeting was as follows,

- 1) To decide regarding implementation of Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) syllabus for B. Pharm
  - 2) To decide regarding implementation of Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) syllabus for M.Pharm
- 
1. Dr. Archana Bhatnagar, OSD, welcome all members and explained them about agenda of meeting. She told that the letter regarding implementation of syllabus was received at college and University. A Faculty coordinator meeting was held on 29<sup>th</sup> May 2017 to discuss this matter at SNDTWU. It was then discussed at the academic council meeting which was held on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2017 at SNDTWU.
  2. Dr. Mahajan told that PCI has given directives to implement the B. Pharmacy and M. Pharmacy syllabus and regulation from academic year 2017-18. The Government Resolution (GR) regarding this, is already passed and the draft syllabus is available online on PCI website from year 2016. The letter regarding this was received to college and University.
  3. Dr. Mahajan further informed that B. Pharmacy syllabus can be implemented from academic year 2017-18.  
Regarding M. Pharmacy in Pharmaceutics, there is no issue. However, M. Pharmacy syllabus recommended by PCI does not include the subject, Herbal Drug Technology (HDT). This course is offered by SNDTWU at present. The nomenclature of M. Pharmacy in Quality Assurance (Q.A.) is mentioned as M. Pharm. in Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance (P.Q.A.) as per PCI.
  4. Dr. Bala Prabhakar detailed about the various steps taken by PCI so far while implementing syllabus since 2016.

5. Dr. Magar asked whether syllabi of M. Pharmacy Quality Assurance (Q.A.) and Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance are same or different. Dr. Mahajan said that both the syllabi are more or less same and there is not much difference.
6. Dr. Tatke explained that M. Pharm. in HDT is a unique course offered by S.N.D.T. Women's University. However, it is not included in PCI syllabus. Dr. Hiremath suggested to convey about M. Pharm. course in HDT to PCI, All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) Government of Maharashtra. Dr. Prabhakar said that HDT syllabus should be submitted to PCI and after approval by PCI the course can then be implemented.
7. Hon. Vice chancellor Prof. Shahsikala Wanjari asked about the decision taken by other Universities regarding implementation of PCI syllabus. Dr. Hiremath from Pune University told that Pune University will take some time for implementation. Dr. Nagarsekar informed that Mumbai University and ICT has denied for PCI syllabus implementation. Dr. Bala Prabhakar told that, NMIMS university is going to implement B. Pharm, as well as M. Pharm. syllabi from the current AY, 2017-2018.
8. Taking different pros and cons into consideration following decisions were made after the discussion
  - i. B. Pharm syllabus as recommended by PCI will be implemented from academic year 2017-18 by SNTWU
  - ii. For M. Pharmacy Quality Assurance  
Nomenclature of course offered by SNTWU: M. Pharmacy Quality Assurance  
New Nomenclature by PCI: Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance  
Hence it was decided to write a letter to PCI and DTE, AICTE regarding this change in nomenclature and implement the PCI recommended syllabus for M.Pharm. Once official change in nomenclature is received from AICTE, PCI and DTE, the implementation of M. Pharm. syllabus can be done from the next academic year, i. e. from 2018-19.
  - iii. It was also decided to write letter to PCI regarding M. Pharmacy course in Herbal Drug Technology, as it is completely new and innovative course and not included in given course names of PCI. The Syllabus of Herbal drug technology will be submitted to PCI for approval.
  - iv. Hence, it was decided that implementation of the M. Pharmacy syllabus recommended by PCI in the next academic year, 2018-19. It was decided to draft a letter to AICTE, PCI and DTE for the same.
9. Hon. Vice Chancellor Prof. Wanjari assured that S.N.D.T. Women's University will provide all required support regarding smooth implementation of new syllabus.
10. Dr. Bhatnagar thanked all for attending the meeting. The meeting was ended with thanks.
