Dr. Jumle has stated that the said amendment was approved by Circulation in the Committee (the said committee was approved by the former Registrar) however due to Paucity of time the same could not be taken up in the then Academic Council meeting. Now since the procedure of election was not completed and there was an urgency and requirement to implement the Companies Act 2016 in syllabus, it was approved by an orders of the Vice-Chancellor as per the powers conferred by the Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016. The decision taken by the vice-chancellor was placed before the house for ratification.

# Information/Discussion

With reference to the Minutes of Board of Deans passed at its meeting held on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2018 this is to state here that the syllabus in the subject of Media and Communication for M.A Semester IV was discussed in the earlier Ad-hoc Board of studies in Communication and Media Studies whereby the structure of all four semesters and the syllabi of first three Semesters was approved.

Further, all the Ad-hoc Boards of Studies were dissolved in August 2017 as well as the then Chairperson Prof. Radha Mishra retired in December 2017 and hence the Semester IV syllabus was not prepared and presented for approval of the Board of Studies in Communication and Media Studies.

Considering the fact that the Semester IV has already commenced and that the Syllabus needs to be implemented w.e.f A.Y 2017-18, Dr. Mira Desai, Professor and I/C HOD, Department of Extension Education prepared the material syllabus in consultation with the previous members of the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Communication and Media Studies as well as industrial professionals and presented it in the special meeting of Board of Deans held on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2018 and the following resolution was passed:

"The Board of Deans discussed and deliberated on the aforesaid Syllabus and resolved that, the Syllabus in the subject of Media and Communication at M.A Semester IV, be recommended to the Academic Council for its approval.

Now since the procedure of election is not yet completed and there was an urgency and requirement to implement the syllabus in the subject of Media and Communication at M.A Semester IV, the same was approved by the orders of the Vice-Chancellor as per the powers conferred by the of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016. The decision taken by the vice-chancellor was placed before the house for ratification.

# Agenda Item No.9

To offer M.A eLearning as M.A. / M.Sc. eLearning at the Department of Educational Technology.

#### Information/Discussion

UGC had approved the Masters programme under innovative programme scheme with the suggested title M.A./M.Sc. Educational Technology in March 2013 to be offered from July 2013. Our University did not use title M.Sc., but had restricted our title to M.A. The department requested UGC to allow us change parenthesis as eLearning (M.A. eLearning) in 2016. They received the permission in March 2017 and hence the programme is now being offered as M.A. eLearning from July 2017. Academic Council has approved this change of parenthesis.

The department has requested to offer title M.A. or M.Sc. with parenthesis "eLearning". Justification:

The Masters programme allows enrolment for graduates from any stream such as B.A., B.F.A., B.Com., B.Sc., B.Sc. Home Science, B.C.A. Since the degree offered after completion of the programme is M.A., they hardly receive any graduate having B.Sc., B.C.A., B.E., B.Tech. degree. Arts graduate many a times do not select this career option thinking that they might not be able to cope up with technologies. This affects overall enrolment.

The department, therefore, proposed that graduates holding B.Sc. degree with any parenthesis and graduates from Computer Science, Architecture, Engineering and Technology may be awarded M.Sc. eLearning degree after successful completion of the 2-year programme. Graduates from any other stream such as Arts, Commerce, Design, Fine Art, etc. may be awarded M.A. eLearning.

A different case of any other graduate related to Science and Technology stream may be brought to the notice of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor for her decision.
