ABOUT COURSE

The 21st century is the century of knowledge society with the feature of a global, private, liberal, and more complex world. Education will be vital to individual, social and national development in the 21st century. According to NEP 2020, one of the objectives of Curriculum and Pedagogy in Schools is "to minimize rote learning and instead encourage holistic development and 21st-century skills such as critical thinking, creativity, scientific temper, communication, collaboration, multilingualism, problem-solving, ethics, social responsibility, and digital literacy" (NEP, 2020).

The course has been designed with the belief that learners are self-motivated and they want to integrate 21st-century skills into their teaching-learning practice as per the requirements of the 21st century. Therefore, the course content has been assigned in online mode (asynchronous and synchronous), and learners can use the course material and choose the learning activities as per their own learning style and pace.

Assessment & Grading

Graded and non-graded assessments will be used in the course for formative and summative assessment.

Graded Assessment: Total 100 marks (25 Marks for one credit) **10 Quizzes** with 5 items and five marks each (10*5=50) **2 Assignments** with 5 marks each (2*5=10). **Course end exam** with 40 objective types questions one mark for each question (40*1=40)

Non-graded assessment: Discussion forums, Case studies, Group work, practice activities, etc.

Certification

Students who have successfully completed all the requirements (Active participation in 70% of non-graded course activities and earned 50% marks in graded formative and summative assessments) of course completion will be awarded a Course completion certificate with credit or noncredit as per the learners choice.
