3. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the NET conducted by UGC or equivalent eligibility tests such as SET/SLET in the discipline of Special Education. The candidates who have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time.
